Eye on Water Customer Portal

Welcome to EyeonWater! Crestview Mutual Water Company has installed automatic meter equipment at your location. Your water readings will now be recorded on a daily basis and those readings will be transmitted in to the cell network where they will be posted to your Eye-On-Water account. You will have the capability to see your water usage using the Eye on Water customer portal.

1. Accessing your account

Visit <u>https://eyeonwater.net/signup</u> on your computer using a supported web browser. You will need to enter your zip code and Under Service Account number you will enter your account number for South Central Regional Water District. This can be found on your bill. If your unable to find your account number. Please call the office and we will be able to provide you with your account number. The account number will contain a hyphen and will be in this format – 00000000-00 (ie 00001001-01; 00001675-04)




3. Main Account Screen

This is the main account screen. The top right shows a comparison of the last 7 days with the previous 7 days. The large graph shows daily usage for the current month. Top left indicates the leak alert area that you can set parameters. Bottom left gives information on reading frequency, last update and when the next update will occur.

4. Show Usage by Month

If you click on month it will show you the usage for that day. You can also use the arrows to toggle between days.



Identifies leak and how fast the leak is



5. Year Delta


Clicking on Month and selecting the Year over Year graph it will show you the monthly water usage with along side the previous years water usage. Hover over the graph and it will give you the usage for both current and previous year in the given month.

6. Show Usage by Day

If you click on day it will show you the usage for that day. You can also use the arrows to toggle between days.



Click on the "?" for a tutorial video on how to navigate through the customer portal.





7. Hourly Water Usage

Clicking on hour and it will show you the hourly water usage for a certain day. You can use the arrows to look at various days. This chart is useful in showing a leak. No household without livestock should show continuous usage every hour of the day. If you do, something is probably leaking. Common culprits include dripping taps, hydrants or toilets running.

8. Set up Leak Notices

Regular service for a household – you would expect intermittent flow or usage – click on that.





9. Set Alarm

Enter your lowest flow to alarm at – here is showing to set at 10 gallons per hour or a little over a pint per minute – may not alarm a dripping tap, but would alarm a running toilet.

10. Email Notifications

Enter how you wish to be contacted. They can email or text, and at what frequency.
